- Naviguide is a European Project, funded by the Leonardo da Vinci Transfer of Innovation Programme

Naviguide: Aims



- The aim is to transfer and expand an existing Austrian guidance methods database, owned by the Austrian Public Employment Agency AMS, into the European guidance system
- The database consists of more than 400 teaching units (methods) for guidance in group settings
- The overall objective is to increase the quality and effectiveness of vocational counselling & therefore support the employability of target groups at risk.
- This will be achieved through the transfer of the guidance methods database to career counsellors who will use the teaching units in their everyday practice
- Six, 1-day train-the-trainer/teacher workshops will take place in each partner country → In total, NAVIGUIDE will reach 720 guidance practitioners & stakeholders.
